LexPhil presents “The New Music Experiment” Musician Participation Application – DEADLINE IS DECEMBER 1, 2011

As a part of the Lexington Philharmonic’s Composer-in-Residence week during February, 2012, the New Music Experiment will foster the creative and innovative spirit by offering composers and musicians at many levels the opportunity to work together and bring new music to life! A performance of several new pieces will take place on February 17th right before the LexPhil concert at Singletary Center for the Arts.

Advanced musicians high school aged and up are encouraged to submit an application to participate in this combination workshop and performance. The workshop portion provides the opportunity to work with professional conductors and composers and will take place 5-7pm, Feb. 12-15, 2011. The culminating concert will be Friday, Feb. 17 at 6pm. Times and locations are subject to change and a final schedule will be communicated to those chosen to participate.

Applications must include:

- The attached form
- A recorded audition
 - o This should include at least two pieces in contrasting style. Both technical proficiency and musicality should be demonstrated.
 - o Recordings may either be audio only or video and may be submitted by mail or electronically.
 - If submitting by mail, please mark clearly with your name and instrument.
 - If submitting electronically, please label attachments with name or provide links to YouTube or other sites. Label any uploaded content with your name.
- At least one written recommendation letter from a private instructor, teacher, or professional musician.
- A written statement explaining why you wish to participate in “The New Music Experiment”.
